New Staff Additions


- We were delighted to welcome Melissa Hunter to our team on August 21st in the role of Director of Development.









Individual Giving




 We continue to see strong engagement on our Facebook page, with a total of 793 content interactions from August 20th to September 16th, greatly exceeding the industry average of 151.
